✓ Safety Checklist



- ☐ **POOR CHIMNEY STRUCTURE** caused by the erosion of bricks & mortar from acidic gases and moisture. Freeze and thaw periods from cold weather can create cracks in your mortar joints, bricks, and flue tiles.
- ☐ **STAINING & LEAKING** caused by cracks in the flue tile & mortar.
- ☐ **DOWN DRAFT SMOKE** coming into the room caused by inefficient draft.
- ☐ **HOUSE FRAMING TOO CLOSE TO CHIMNEY** National codes require 2" minimum clearance.
- ☐ **INADEQUATE DRAFT** is often caused by an improper flue size as required by your appliance specifications.
- ☐ **A BROKEN CHIMNEY STRUCTURE** can allow smoke, fire embers, carbon dioxide, and other gases into the living space of your house.
- ☐ **BROKEN OR MISSING FLUE TILES** increases the risk dramatically of a chimney fire and/or carbon monoxide leaking into the house.
